IMR Test Labs (IMR) received one shower head (model H106-R-1) and a black restrictor. IMR was requested to determine the water usage in gallons per minutes.


DISCUSSION

The shower head was attached to house water, with the black restrictor in place. The water was turned on to the shower head and the water flow was captured in a five gallon bucket. The water was poured from the bucket into a graduated cylinder for accurate measurement. The test time was 10 seconds with the test repeated three times.
